


THE CURIOUS CASE OF THE MASQUED MAGICIAN

The production period will take place in the second half of 2025. As such detailed set, lighting and sound specifications will not be available until 2026. However, given our ambition to tour the show to mid-scale venues/theatres (200-400 seating capacity) and for the show to include beautiful Edwardian sets and costumes and large array of magic (including illusions, escapology, mentalism and cardistry) we currently envisage the following.

We envisage sound effects being operated from the company's laptop which will need to plug in to venue's mixing desk (3.55mm jack for laptop). Minimum set-up: L/R stereo PA System Ideal set-up: L/R stereo PA System in auditorium, stage L/R speakers for foldback and position plotted SFX
