Manual handling	Injury to staff while unloading/loading the set for the show	Performers, public, staff	1	2	3	Set and Props will be transported in small sections and assembled on site. Set and props are packed in mobile wheeled boxes..
Manual handling	Dangers associated with erection of scenery	Performers	1	1	2	Set to be erected by trained personnel in adequate light under supervision of experienced supervisor. The same staff to derig as erected. Access equipment used safely with care.
Performance Injury	Performer falling during performance	Performers	1	1	2	Performers are well rehearsed in the play and will be rehearsed in the venue to ensure any potentially dangerous movements are completely safe.
